## AMBA Announces New 2023 Sourcebook and Cover Contest Winner


With an increased circulation of more than 2,000 Sourcebooks annually, AMBA distributes directories to AMBA members, as well as to additional mold manufacturers and mold buyers at tradeshows and other industry events throughout the year. AMBA members also have the opportunity to showcase a unique project by participating in the *Sourcebook* Cover Contest, which was established to promote the quality craftsmanship of AMBA mold manufacturers.

This year's cover features a micro-fluidic medical device mold – a high-risk project that proved to be one of the most challenging for 2023 contest winner Westminster Tool, Inc. The final product required several technical features, including complex angled slides, multi-cam action shutoffs and a micro-fluidic feature – all of which were nearly impossible to machine with traditional approaches.

What separated this impressive mold from all other complex jobs at Westminster Tool was the amount of dedicated research and innovation that went into its perfect execution. With an extremely small end mill and high-precision polishing, the Westminster team was able to hit the tight-tolerance requirements of the micro-fluidic feature while also meeting stringent surface finish requirements.
