# **ELIGIBILITY**

Additionally, if member companies have teamed up, both companies can be nominated on the same form and if chosen, would split the scholarship grant. The award recipient will be the company as a whole. If you believe that significant strides have been made in education and/or recruitment, we encourage you to send in your nomination! What types of outreach have you done in 2023? What are your plans for 2024? How has the outreach drawn youth to the industry? Has your outreach, program or initiative helped the mold manufacturing industry gain visibility and if so in what ways and with what audiences (i.e., high school students, junior high students, technical trade students, parents, teachers, counselors, etc.)?
